### The Empowerment Summit

ReCapturing The Vision's annual Empowerment Summit is a national model for intervention and empowerment. Through a series of interactive workshops, the Summit provides teens with the tools and insight to redirect their lives towards success. Past keynotes speakers and special guests include Dr. Bernice king, Dwayne Wade Sr., T-Bone, Kirk Franklin, Donna Robinson, and Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson.

### **Table Etiquette**

All too often students are not taught the art and importance of table etiquette and are met with feelings of inadequacies when dining informal situations. To combat all of these concerns, students will receive table etiquette training. Table etiquette fundamentals are taught to students in a classroom setting with activities that demonstrate proper utensil usage and how to arrange a single place setting. To provide an immersive experience and practical application, students are taken on an etiquette field trip to apply their learnings.






